HCER Senior Men's Golf League members represent the Hudson Community because we are sponsored by the Hudson Community Education and Recreation Department (HCER). We play golf in the presence of the public. We play golf as respected friends and colleagues of other League members. Thus, each League member has a responsibility to demonstrate good sportsmanship and etiquette on and around the course, including avoiding profanity, outbursts of temper, throwing equipment, distracting fellow players, and by following all League and course rules. The use of cell phones during play should be restricted to emergencies only.

As a participant in the HCER Senior Men's Golf League, you are expected to behave in a manner that reflects a positive image of the League and HCER. Failure to uphold this Code will result in disciplinary action by the Leadership Team and the Director of HCER including a warning, suspension from League play, or expulsion from the League.

All players must verify that they have read and understand the Code, and that they will uphold the Code at all times while participating in the League by sending an acknowledgement to the League Coordinator by Friday, April 14, 2023.
