## 2023 Duties of a Group Captain

For each round, a player in each group is designated as the Captain and the Assistant Captain. Their duties of the include:

- (1) To promote good sportsmanship, wholesome language, and proper course etiquette as stated in the Code of Conduct.
- (2) To encourage a fast pace of play. To strictly enforce the USGA rule limiting the search for a lost ball to 3 minutes.
- (3) If requested, to print a copy of the scoresheet provided by the League Coordinator and bring it to the course. To keep score, or request someone to keep score. At the end of each hole, the scorer should double-check the scores with the players.
- (4) At the end of the round, total all scores and review the scores and totals with their group.
- (5) If requested, to provide a photo of the completed scoresheet to the League Coordinator by 5 pm on the day of the round. Once a scoresheet is turned in, only clerical errors by the League Coordinator may be corrected.
- (6) If Captain of the first group, ensure that prize markers are placed properly. If Captain of the last group, ensure that all prize markers are picked up and turned in to the League Coordinator or Host.
